

JBS – Other Operations


 JBS is the leading lamb producer and exporter at 24,000 sheep daily

• JBS is Brazil's 3rd largest dairy producer with a daily production capacity of 5,400 tonnes.




JBS - Revenue by Geographic Region






JBS – Revenue by Segment
