#### Thailand's poultry industry

- 10<sup>th</sup> largest producer of broiler meat
- 5<sup>th</sup> largest exporter of broiler meat
- 92% exports are cooked chicken meat
- largest exporter of cooked chicken
- 85% of exports to Japan and EU

- 66 processing plants
- 25 frozen foods plants
- 13,000 farms
- 6 major companies
- integrated producers processing 3.85 million birds/day
- cooked meat production
- feed, hatcheries, farms, retailers, restaurants

#### **Cargill Meats Thailand**

- 2 plants Saraburi and Korat
- 9,500 workers
- fully integrated hatcheries, feed mills,processing facilities
- owns or contracts farms in 22 provinces

#### **Cargill Meats Thailand**

- 80% exported to Japan, EU, Canada & Hong Kong
- McWings to EU, Hong Kong
- June 2011 new US\$110 million investment
- expansion of Korat plant
- additional 2,000 workers

#### organizing environment

- 600,000 workers
- 150,000 workers in processing
- 85% women
- migrant workers (Burma, Laos, Cambodia)
- only one plant union
- union density is 0.0007%

#### working environment

- low basic wages (US\$5.60 to US\$7.50/day)
- no standard wage increase
- wage deductions
- PPE costs deducted (8 to 15% of basic wages)
- forced overtime
- restricted toilet breaks/rest breaks
- target quota bonus scheme

#### working environment

- discrimination/unequal treatment
- migrant workers
- housing/dormitories
  - Cargill Meat Saraburi
- 4,000 workers
- 260 migrant workers (Laos) in chicken sausage/meatball plant

- joint project with ILO on Avian Influenza H5N1
- research/mapping
- training workshops on H5N1
- access to workers
- access to government agencies
- access to employers
- ILO endorsement

- contacts in 14 factories
- 50,000 workers
- Poultry Workers Rights Network
- 130 worker activists
- workshops/training on H5N1
- health & safety rights training
- trade union education

- stop illegal wage deductions for PPE
- policy intervention through ILO
- ILO national tripartite conference 20
   January 2009 Labor Ministry clarified
   "employers must provide PPE to
   workers for free"
- "PPE is free" awareness campaign
- posters/pamphlets in 3 languages

# New Labor Protection OHS regulations (2006)

- compulsory OHS committees
- 5 out of 11 committee members must be workers' reps
- workers' reps elected in ballot
- 2 year terms
- demand implementation
- challenge fake or ineffective committees
- train activists to get elected

#### organizing campaign

- public campaign
  Stop Bird Flu! = Protecting Poultry
  Workers = Protecting the Public
- move from OSH committees to trade unions
- win union recognition
- organize across 14 factories
- national recognition
